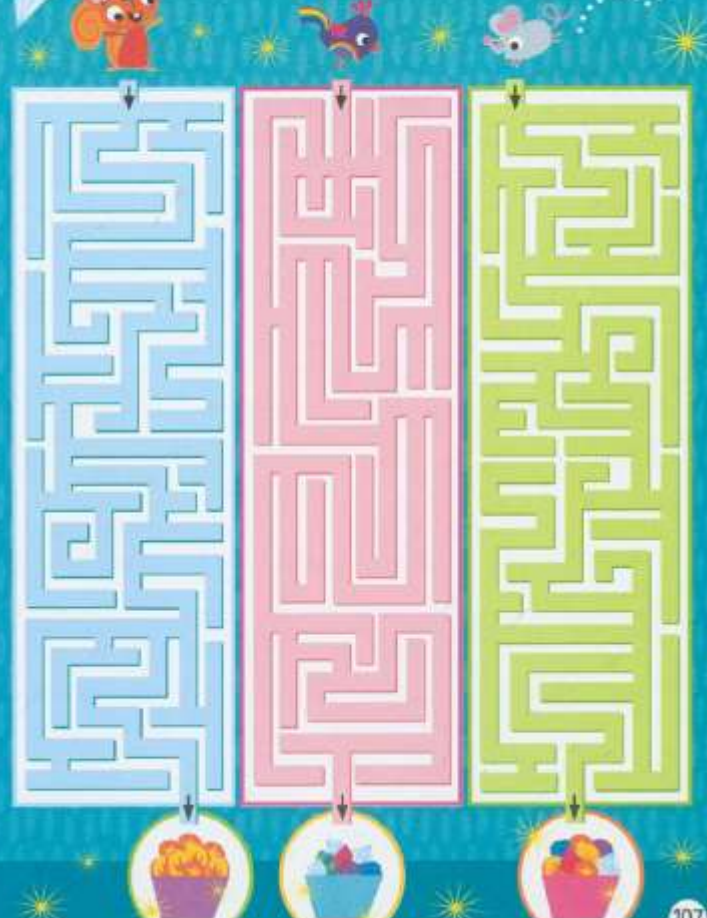
SEASIDE FEAST
