Homework Expectations

<u>Task 1 – Spelling</u>: This week students have started PLD List 1 for their level. These words are now their focus for homework in Week 2.Students will complete a different task with them each night. *Monday* – write words our using the LOOK, SAY (Sound Out), Cover, Write and Check. Students are to make sure that they write each sound in a different coloured pencil eg. captive own class. *Tuesday* – Write words in alphabetical order. Students are to make sure that they write each sound in a different coloured pencil as they are completing the activity. *Wednesday* – build on the base words. e.g. grew/growing or waterfall or captivated. *Thursday* – write 5 sentences using any of their list words. Make sure you are aiming for compound or complex sentence structure. If you have any questions about this task, please contact me.

<u>Task 2 – Mathematics Sheet</u>: Students are to complete the sheet. If they are having difficulty remind them to ask for assistance at school. Students will also bring home the number fact focus for multiplication and division to practice. They need to be able to complete this sheet in 6 minutes.

<u>Task 3 – Reading</u>: Students should be reading regularly and they can choose a text of their choice. Once they have recorded their reading for the week, please sign to say that you have witnessed or asked them about what they have been reading.

In **English,** students have been given their mark for their Character Analysis task. This week they will be publishing their Fantasy Chapter and be given the opportunity to print it out to share with you at home.

This week in **Mathematics** all students will be completing their symmetry assessment. Year 6 also have an assessment task on locating ordered pairs in any one of the four quadrants of the Cartesian plane.
